Signs of illness	Interventions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • blow to head, neck and / or abdomen • persistent bleeding • persistent or severe pain in joints • joint swelling or limited movement • discoloration of skin or bruising • temperature elevation especially over the joints or the injured area • 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • avoid weight bearing or stress to any injured or painful area • put ice on all impact blows and lacerations • call 9-1-1 if blow is to head, neck or abdomen • contact Security and transport in a cart to the Health Office if joint pain or discoloration • •

Call 9-1-1 when:

- Injury to the head, neck, or abdomen.
- Severe or persistent pain and parents cannot be reached
- Difficult, painful, or absent breathing.
- Unconscious or unresponsive.
