Ask your doctor to consider
prescribing a preferred medication.

As of <Effective Date>, some nasal steroid allergy medications will no longer be covered by your prescription drug benefit unless you obtain approval through a coverage review.

Fluticasone (generic for *Flonase*[®]), flunisolide (generic for *Nasarel*[®]), and *Nasonex*[®] will continue to be covered as preferred drugs.

- *Beconase AQ*[®], *Rhinocort AQ*[®], *Nasarel*[®], *Flonase*[®], *Nasacort AQ*[®], *Omnaris*[®], and *Veramyst*[®] will no longer be covered as preferred drugs. If you purchase any of these medications after <Effective Date>, you will be responsible for the entire cost unless you obtain prior approval through a coverage review.
- Nasal steroids such as fluticasone, flunisolide, and *Nasonex* will continue to be covered by your plan.

Your total cost will be lower by using fluticasone, flunisolide or *Nasonex*.

- Save even more by using your mail-order pharmacy benefit, **Medco By Mail**, for your long-term drugs if your plan offers a mail-order benefit. You'll get the convenience of up to a 90-day supply of medication delivered right to you, and you'll pay less over time than you would at a retail pharmacy.

Ask your doctor to consider prescribing fluticasone, flunisolide or *Nasonex* so you can pay less.

- **Talk to your doctor** and ask whether fluticasone, flunisolide or *Nasonex* would be right for you.
- If your doctor agrees, ask for a new prescription.
- For long-term use, have your doctor write a prescription for **up to a 90-day supply**, plus refills for up to 1 year (if appropriate).
- Then have your doctor fax the prescription to Medco By Mail using the enclosed form.

If your doctor believes you should use a non-preferred nasal steroid allergy medication, you or your doctor can request a coverage review. He or she can call toll-free 1 800 417-1764, 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., eastern time, Monday through Friday. If the review is approved, you will pay your plan's appropriate brand-name co-payment/coinsurance for the medication, which may be higher than what you would pay for the plan-preferred alternatives.
